



AMGA members are welcomed to nominate any registered Murray Grey, cows, bulls, weaned calves, yearlings, bred heifers, 4-H steers, embryos and semen. Please read the Terms and Conditions included in this mailing.

How it works –

1 – You nominate an animal to the sale

2 – The sale committee considers the photo and general information

A – Nominations will not be refused for herd of origin, pedigree, or style of management

B – All nominations will be accepted if they conform to AMGA registry rules, appear healthy and thrifty, reflect well on the consignor and the breed.

3 – Consignor is notified of approval and is then invited to send more pictures and videos.

4 – Each consignor will have a webpage for additional media, commentary, and we will post videos on YouTube.

5 – AMGA will produce an online sale catalog (limited prints for non – computer bidders)

6 – Bidders will register with AMGA and be able to pre-bid by phone or text only

7 – You keep your consignment at home until the check clears AMGA bank (all purchase payments shall be to AMGA) and then the buyer will contact you. Transportation is up to the buyer
